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

3	TREE CARE PROGRAM	NSS	REGULAR ACTIVITY	28.08.2018	22	The volunteers nurtured the tree inside and outside the








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						campus to preserve the greenery and the environment. The local inhabitants learned about taking care of trees which are an integral part of the biodiversity.




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						villagers of Khaspur area were being taught to tackle various health issues and educational problem existed in the area.


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						condition of that area for safeguarding the public health.




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						initiatives to sensitize the local people about the harmful aspect of alcohol and tobacco consumption.
