#### **Brief Summary of the Course**

The College arranged an array of add-on courses for the students during the summer vacation 2025, with the central objectives to provide students with additional skills and knowledge beyond their core curriculum, enhance employability and career prospects, and also boost their self-confidence and develop their personality. It can foster a well-rounded education that contributes to their overall growth and opens new dimensions in their academic journey. The short-term course on Peace and Justice was organised by the Department of Philosophy, Political Science, and History in Blended mode during the last week of the summer vacation (i.e. 23/06/2025 — 30/06/2025).
