- 4. It is now about five months that the human resource of the college is enriched with the joining of a full-time permanent librarian who, since his joining, has been working to set up the central library with the assistance of academic departments, college office and the guidance of IQAC. Members are of the view that the college library still needs the service of Mr. Swarajit Das, an external expert on library science, working temporarily for about five years. Following demands from academic departments, the IQAC has requested the librarian to prioritize the remaining task of cataloguing the books, hampered severely by the pandemic, and make them available for students as soon as possible.
- 5. To boost up an eco-friendly green campus together with sustaining a cost effective college canteen, members have suggested carving out some space near the college canteen to grow a medicinal garden and a kitchen garden. The responsibility has been assigned to the NSS unit who has been advised to make a list of plants relevant for the purpose and purchase the saplings as soon as possible such that they can be planted before the end of the monsoon.
- 6. In the matters arising, the Department of History proposed to organize a seminar "Swadhinotar 75 bochor: Protyasha o Prapti" on the 75th Independence Day 15.08.2022. The members welcomed the initiative and accepted the proposal.

#### Minutes of the meeting

1. Five teachers namely Liza Dutta (Philosophy), Nitish Ghosh (Bengali), Pritin Dutta (Political Science), Saidul Haque (English) and Md. Najir Hossain (Philosophy) have completed all the requirements for their promotion by CAS from Assistant Professor Stage-I to Stage-II. IQAC have checked their necessary documents. A separate resolution has been prepared for communicating to the Affiliating University and the Director of Public Instruction to seek respectively the subject expert(s) and the govt. nominee to form respective Screening Committee separately for promotion of each teacher.

2. As it has been observed that students' attendance in the classes is not yet satisfactory compared to pre covid era, special measures need to be taken for the improvement of the situation. To assess the ground reality clearly, it has been decided to arrange a parent-teacher meeting as soon as possible. The respective sub-committee of the college has been assigned to devise plans to increase the participation of parents in such meetings. In addition, to address the students' psyche, IQAC has requested the cademic departments to implement the mentor-mentee process with sufficient care

It has been also decided to build up an effective feedback mechanism for students as well as other stakeholders such as faculty members, office staff and possibly members of the alumni & parents to address drawbacks in various institutional processes and thereafter analyze the responses to take coordinated measures for quality improvement.

4. Already five academic batches from our college have completed their curriculum. The college is now at a stage for the assessment and accreditation by NAAC. It has been decided to activate the NAAC preparation sub-committee for this purpose. Particularly, Sumit Kumar Das (Assistant Professor in Physics and one of the joint-convenor of this sub-committee) and the IQAC coordinator have taken the responsibility to communicate with experts from other institutions and participate in workshops organized by the government or other institutions on this matter to have hands-on-knowledge besides studying related materials provided by NAAC itself. The Officer-in-Charge (chairperson of IQAC) has also expressed his eagerness to accompany and participate in these programmes whenever possible.

#### Minutes of the meeting

Meeting started in due time. Followings resolutions have been recorded unanimously in the meeting:

- 1. Following pushes by the state government to all the higher institutions under its jurisdiction to get accredited by NAAC as early as possible, the IQAC has decided to organize an extended meeting this time. The extended meeting is focused on building up a primary level awareness for all the faculty members including the librarian about the necessary measures an institution like ours need to take for its assessment and accreditation by NAAC and thereafter preparing ourselves for due action. This was necessary as our college will go through the first cycle of NAAC accreditation and barring a few senior teachers in their past workplace, most of the faculty members are yet to have direct experience. Sumit Kumar Das, the joint convenor of NAAC preparation sub-committee was assigned for the role of demonstrator.
  - (a) Sumit first sketched the key sequential aspects like IIQA, SSR, DVV, PTV, etc. This was followed by a little elaboration on the SSR part such as profile (& extended profile) and seven criteria based key indicators with associated qualitative & quantitative metrics.
  - (b) Eight faculty members have been given the roles of in-charge for the profile and each of seven criteria. Rest of the faculty members have been assigned to assist those in-charges. The IQAC has suggested the faculty members to go through the respective parts of NAAC manual, guidelines & standard operational procedures (SOP) for detailed methodology and then sketch out the respective tasks.
- 2. It has been noticed that the institution has to satisfy some minimum eligibility criteria like affiliation (at least temporary) even to go for the first step of NAAC accreditation, namely the IIQA submission. After academic activities started from session 2015-16, our college was given temporary affiliation for two consecutive academic sessions 2015-16 and 2016-17 by University of Kalyani. Affiliation was not extended further pointing towards our shortage in land area as stipulated by UGC. To resolve this issue, IQAC has assigned the UGC sub-committee of the college to take the matter once again to the University and possibly to the Higher Education

Department, Govt. of West Bengal. Alongside, it has been decided that college authority needs to engage with the local administration of government to address the shortage of land.

- 3. In the matters arising, several issues were raised.
  - (a) It has been decided that teachers will be released for FIP/RC on the basis of their due date of promotion together with academic & administrative constraints of the college. However, the Officer-in-Charge has assured that enough care must be taken such that the career of any teacher is not hampered due to delayed release for FIP/RC.
  - (b) Confirmation of service for several teachers, sanctioning of maternity leave of two female teachers are pending at Bikash Bhavan. The Officer-in-Charge has assured to look after the matters.
- 4. Many of the components of academic infrastructure such as printers, photocopy machine, scanner, UPS together with various components of physical infrastructure such as water purifier, lights and fan have become non-functional. Condition of the toilets became very poor as well. Several window glasses have been found to be broken. The Officer-in-Charge has pointed out the lack of funds but later on also promised to resolve the matter as early as possible by arranging funds.

An electrifying meeting ended with a vote of thanks extended by the coordinator.

#### Minutes of the meeting

Once again the IQAC has decided to organize an extended meeting comprising all the faculty members including the librarian to assess the preparedness of faculty members for NAAC accreditation and sort out long term and immediate tasks in this direction besides discussions on other issues. Followings are the resolutions recorded:

- Initially, joint convenor of NAAC preparation sub-committee and IQAC coordinator
  tried to address the queries on different criteria of NAAC manual. IQAC then
  reviewed the tasks sketched by the in-charges of all the criteria and requested them to
  carry out the tasks. It has been decided to seek consultation from district or state level
  mentors appointed by the state government for clarification of unresolved queries.
- 2. The IQAC has also decided to now drive for building up awareness of the office staff for an overview of NAAC processes and their detailed role in this regard.
- 3. Following the guidelines of NAAC on the functionaries of IQAC, it has been resolved that the key decisions regarding all the institutional processes (academic, administrative & financial) should be made after considerations of the matter by IQAC. While implementation of the process, close coordination is expected to be maintained with the Teachers' Council.
- 4. Nitish Ghosh (Assistant Professor in Bengali) and Saidul Haque (Assistant Professor in English) have been assigned the responsibility for conducting Academic and Administrative Audit of the college with the possible assistance of Sumit Kumar Das (joint convenor of NAAC preparation sub-committee) and Sk Basiruddin (Assistant Professor in Chemistry).
- 5. The librarian has been suggested to take necessary steps in converting the gallery attached with the central library into a dedicated reading zone for the students. IQAC has also requested the Officer-in-charge to arrange funds for installation of KOHA Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) for the automation of the library. This will enable the users to access the library collection through Web-OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) from anywhere anytime.

- 6. Citing previous instances, IQAC has urged the faculty members to internalize the process for comprehensive support for needy students as well as measures for preventing early marriage of girl students. Members have agreed to take more measures on gender sensitization & women empowerment. These could be habituated as best practices of our college. This small leap towards building gender and socioeconomic equity could be our institutional distinctiveness as well.
- 7. IQAC has resolved to take various initiatives for upholding a clean and green campus-
  - (a) Installation of solar panels on the rooftop of college Building and more LED lights respectively as alternate sources of energy and for energy conservation.
  - (b) Conservation of rain water through rain water harvesting and use it for watering plants and trees.
  - (c) Observation of World environment day, World water day, Earth Day, etc. to sensitize the students and setting posters, banners and signs in various locations within the college premises emphasizing eco friendly practices.
  - (d) Awareness programme to save energy and water particularly through NSS unit. Susmita Chowdhury (Assistant Professor in Chemistry) has been assigned to involve students in a field work to determine the iron & arsenic content of the water of Jalangi river and emphasize the importance of Jalangi river among the local people.
  - (e) To assess the current status of green and eco-friendly campus and necessity for further actions, members proposed to carry out a Green Audit, responsibility for which is assigned to Shubhadip Debnath (Assistant Professor in Bengali).
    He may seek the help of Raghunath Roy (TCS & Assistant Professor of History), Debabrata Mondal (Data Entry Operator) and Tridip Sinha (Upper

Division Clerk).

8. The proposal by the seminar sub-committee to organize a one day state level seminar on Research Methodology by the end of March, 2023 has been accepted. The seminar sub-committee has been asked to finalize on the names of resource persons and the tentative date without any delay.

#### Minutes of the meeting

The proposal that SK Basiruddin (Assistant Professor in Chemistry) would act as the stand-in coordinator of IQAC to ensure its uninterrupted functioning has been greeted by everyone present in the meeting. The following resolutions were recorded:

- Academic departments, library and the college office have been requested to submit their respective annual proposals for requirements of various academic and physical infrastructures for the new financial year to the purchase sub-committee as soon as possible in order to prepare & send the budgetary proposals & funds estimation of the college to the Govt. of West Bengal.
- 2. IQAC has figured out that there are certain indicators of excellence which, so far, were not looked after properly in our college from its inception. College needs to take immediate measures not only to improve NAAC scoring but also to enhance the academic quality and ambience of the college. Organizing add-on courses, workshops on soft skill or communication skill, etc., seminars particularly on or involving research methodology, intellectual property rights, conducting study tours & field study, building collaborations, MoU's with other institutions are some of the areas identified for this purpose.
- 3. Considering prior inputs from the academic departments, it has been decided that for the academic year 2022-23, three Add-on courses will be offered by the college and all three courses will be organized within the upcoming summer vacation. The courses "Indian tradition and culture", "Basic computer applications & working with internets" and "Gender studies: an introduction" will take place tentatively from 17.05.2023 to 25.05.2023, from 26.05.2023 to 03.06.2023 and from 05.06.2023 to 13.06.2023 respectively.

4. In addition, the IQAC has also decided to organize a one day yoga workshop on 21.06.2023 (International Day of Yoga) and a two-day workshop on "Communication Skills" from 26.06.2023 to 27.06.2023.

Following a circular from University of Kalyani to introduce 4 year undergraduate courses from the upcoming academic session 2023-24 without keeping any provision separately for General/Programme courses in Science or Arts, the members have agreed to the proposal for offering B.Sc. major courses in Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics from the upcoming session together with distributing seats of B.A. Programme course among major courses in Arts subjects. The coordinator has taken the responsibility to prepare the detailed proposals and send them to the affiliating university as well as the DPI, Govt. of West Bengal immediately.
- 2. Observing unsatisfactory progress in the preparedness of the college for NAAC accreditation, members are of the opinion to form a dedicated NAAC steering committee to boost up the process. Supratim Mukherjee, Assistant Professor in Mathematics will act as the convenor of this committee which will be chaired by the Officer-in-Charge and will also comprise of IQAC coordinator, both the joint tonvenors of NAAC preparation sub-committee, secretary of Teachers' Council and enior teacher Swarup Ranjan Sahoo (Associate Professor in Physics).

The members are of the opinion that a thriving college should have an active alumni association. Although our faculty members have maintained contacts with the past students, many of whom enthusiastically visit the college particularly during cultural events. In order that current students as well as the college as a whole get enriched with regular active consultation and engagement from the alumni, the association needs to register. This may slightly boost our case for NAAC accreditation also. Sumit Kumar Das, the joint convenor of NAAC preparation sub-committee, has taken the responsibility for necessary action.

4. IQAC reviewed the the progress of Academic & Administrative Audit and Green Audit.
