PROGRAMME

The Department of History embarked on its inaugural educational excursion in the academic year 2022-23, following the inclusion of the subject in the Skill Enhancement Programme. The excursion was attended by 27 students (6 male and 21 female) accompanied by 3 teaching faculty members (2 male and 1 female). As part of the revised CBCS syllabus introduced by the University of Kalyani on 29th April 2021, History and Tourism in India was incorporated into the Skill Enhancement Programme (SEC). Unit 4 of the syllabus focuses on revisiting Bengal at Kolkata, providing a unique opportunity for students to explore and experience the region through the lens of a historian.

The Department of History organized an educational tour to Plassey on 30th June 2023. The programme included:

- 1. Visit to the Plassey Battlefield
- 2. Guided tour of the Plassey Museum
- 3. Interactive session with Teachers' and Students'.
- 4. Discussion on the significance of the Battle of Plassey




